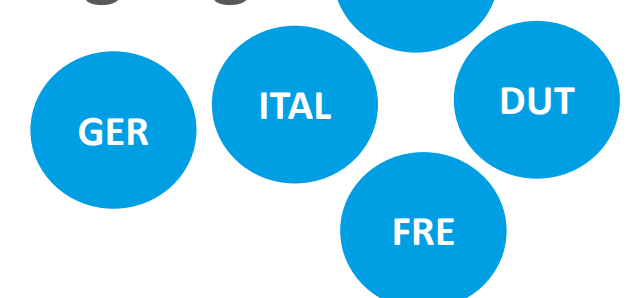

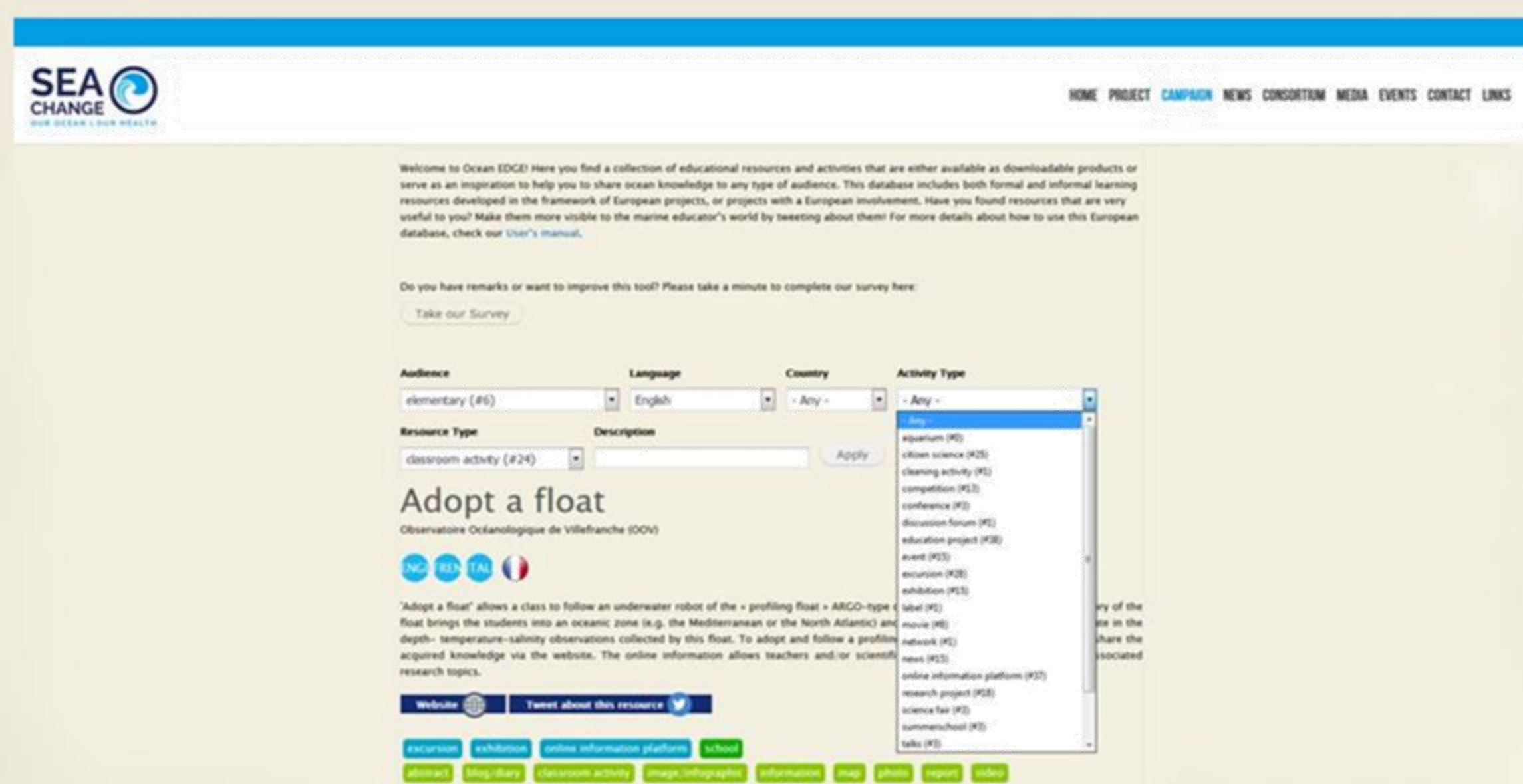

Good Examples

All records in the database must:

- contain **scientifically correct** information
- Provide directly **downloadable materials**
OR provide an abstract detailed enough to serve as a **true inspiration** for other activities.

Ocean EDGE started with the careful **selection** of **133** good practices out of lists & abstract books from marine E&O experts & conferences



They were tagged & grouped, in order to create the final database structure.

An online **users survey** is linked to the database for evaluation
